Launched a five-week summer internship program allowing youth to apply life skills to realworld experience.

Expanded the depth of services at Bassick High School, **tripling** the number of students served.

Initiated *ASCENSION*, an introduction to Elevate for middle school students at Bridge Academy facilities led by high school seniors.

Replicate the behavior modification program, *Making Money Moves*, to maximize student engagement and achievement.

Expand our model to one middle school, a feeder school for Bassick High School. Interactions with Teacher-Mentors during and after middle school will increase the likelihood of middle school students succeeding in high school and beyond.

Expand our model to a second middle school, a feeder school for Bridge Academy.

Two additional TeacherMentors would be
dedicated to
implementing the
Elevate Bridgeport
middle school curriculum
for 7th- and 8th-grade
students to help them
develop transferable life
skills and character
qualities to increase their
likelihood of high school
success and beyond.

Expand our program to an additional school, Harding High School.

This additional High School will present Elevate Bridgeport with the opportunity to serve three of five Bridgeport neighborhoods and two of four Bridgeport Public High Schools.

This critical expansion will help increase our annual impact to serve more than 1,100 students per year.
